BLAKE MILLER



Blake Miller became head coach at Texas A&M-Kingsville in the summer of 2007 after posting a two year record of 64-44 at Darton College, including the school's first Region XVII Championship and a trip to the 2006 NJCAA Division I World Series.

Just as impressive was the success that Darton had in the classroom under Miller's leadership. In his first year the team posted a cumulative team grade point average of 3.26 and his 2007 squad posted the top team GPA in the NJCAA with a 3.59 mark.

Miller has been an assistant at both the NCAA Division I and NCAA Division II levels with stints at East Tennessee State (2005), Missouri Western (2004) and Mesa State (2001-03).

While at Mesa State, he helped lead the Mavericks to a pair of NCAA Division II regional appearances (2001, 2002) while setting the NCAA Division II record for most home runs in a season with 98 in 2002.

Miller also established himself as one of the best men's fast pitch softball players in the country as a member of the USA National Team.

In 12 years of professional level fast pitch competition, Miller garnered four first-team All-American awards and was selected to the USA Men's National Fast Pitch Team on five different occasions. During this period, he captured a Gold Medal in the 2002 Pan American Qualifier in Guatemala City, Guatemala, and a Silver Medal in the 2003 Pan American Games in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.

Renee Hietbrink

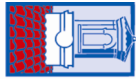


Renee Hietbrink brings a wealth of knowledge as both a coach and former collegiate pitcher to the Texas A&M-Kingsville staff.

Pitching: Javelina Softball Camp includes a session for pitching fundamentals for all levels. Proper mechanics are taught to both new and experienced pitchers. Pitchers will learn the proper delivery techniques and how to develop different pitches, drills and warm-up routines.

Hitting: Hitting sessions will provide the basic mechanics of hitting, drills and tee work. (Please bring a helmet and bat if you have them.)

Defense: Specialized instruction is provided for each position, including the proper mechanics and drills to make you a better fielder.

Base Running: Javelina Softball camp includes a session to learn the techniques of base running and sliding.

Game Situations: Campers will get to use the skills they learn in game-like situations.
