The Javelinas have conducted over fifty (50) community engagements, community service and public speaking engagements during the 2009-2010 school year. Just to name a few projects, the Javelina men's basketball team assisted the Kleberg County Historical Commission by moving 113 boxes of Kleberg County History books from the vacated Kingsville Publishing Co. building, where they had been stored, to the library.

Another great event was the "Live the Dream Relay", the Javelinas teamed up with Special Olympics Texas for a relay race involving student-athletes from Texas A&M Kingsville, Incarnate Word, UT-Pan American, Texas A&M –Corpus Christi and Special Olympics Texas.

The Javelinas held another inaugural event on February 13th when the Javelina Athletic Staff hosted over 100 couples at the Valentine's Dinner event that included dinner and comedian at the Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Center.
